Seismic Public Meeting Notice

To the citizens of Lafourche, Jefferson, and Plaquemines Parishes, Louisiana

Geokinetics will be conducting seismic activity within a 36.45 square mile project area. The project will take place 15 miles south east of Lafitte, Louisiana in the areas of Bayou Cutler, Bayou St. Denis, Bayou Dosgris, Grand Bayou, Mud Lake, Lake Five, Wilkinson Canal, Manila Village; ending on the North side of Barataria Bay. The purpose of this survey is to provide a high-resolution image of the subsurface geological features which will allow the seismic company or client to effectively evaluate the hydrocarbons reserves underlying the project area. The survey requires the deployment of motion sensing devices (geophones) which would be deployed at regular intervals (220 feet), with spacing between receiver lines of 1320 feet. The survey design will also incorporate energy sources, which would be placed at regular intervals in a grid pattern throughout the project area.

There will be a public meeting located at the Jean Lafitte Multi Purpose Center starting a 6:00 pm on September 20, 2017 to answer any questions pertaining to this seismic survey.

The survey will begin October 1, 2017 and last until approximately December 15, 2017.
