



## Military / Police Hunter Education Exemption Application

As per L.R.S. 56:699.5, active or veteran members of the United States armed services, POST- certified law enforcement officers, or current POST-certified persons may apply for an exemption to the Louisiana hunter education certification requirements.

To apply for this exemption, you must:

1. Have a louisianaoutdoors.com account (If you have ever purchased a Louisiana Hunting or Fishing License you should already have an account).

2. Return the following to the address below:
  - A. This form, completed and signed
  - B. A copy of your driver's license
  - C. Credentials;
    1. Law Enforcement – a copy of your current post-certification card
    2. Military – a copy of your DD214 or active duty ID.
